BYOxLink – How to Guide

Use guest Wi-Fi service to connect a student's MacOS device

This document explains how a student can connect a MacOS device to the school guest Wi-Fi network (EQGUEST) so staff can then complete the Intune enrollment on their device.

The guest Wi-Fi connection is limited and only lasts for eight (8) hours. You may not be able to access some resources such as shared network drives, printers or local school websites through the guest Wi-Fi.

Note: Sign on will only work with a valid school email address (<username>@eq.edu.au>). You should use your existing school EQ email address.

Step 1. Select the guest Wi-Fi network

- a. Select the CWi-Fi icon in the menu bar at the top of the screen
- b. Select the EQGUEST Wi-Fi network.
- c. A sign on page will be displayed.







Step 2. Sign on to the guest Wi-Fi network

- a. A Sign on page will be displayed
- b. Enter your EQ email address and password
- c. Read and accept the Acceptable Use Policy by ticking the box
- d. Select Sign On.



e. A success screen will display, close the window.



Step 3. Change Wi-Fi Proxy settings

- a. Select the $\ensuremath{\overline{\ensuremath{\mathcal{M}}}}$ Wi-Fi icon in the menu bar at the top of the screen
- b. Select Open Network Preferences.







c. Select Advanced.
