

STUDENTS DRIVING TO SCHOOL POLICY

Dear Parents and Caregivers

All of our Year 12 students are now 'prep students', which means that they completed Prep before starting Year 1. This means that our Year 12 students are typically at least 6 months older than previous cohorts of Year 12s.

One implication of this change is that more of our Year 12s are getting their Provisional Licences while still at school, and are therefore more likely be able to drive to and from school in their own car.


As such, we want to make sure that we are putting in place clear expectations for our students about what is expected of them when using a car to get to and from school, and when they leave their cars parked on school grounds.

Our goal is simple: to do our bit to make sure our kids are safe when in a car, whether they are the driver or the passenger. The Register form on the other side of this sheet simply allows us to know:

- a) That they actually do have their Provisional Licence
- b) What cars should have a right to park on school grounds
- c) That passengers have the consent of parents of both the driver and the passenger to be in the car.

We're seeking your support to make sure your children know what is expected of them when using a car to get to school, so we can do a better job at ensuring their safety.
